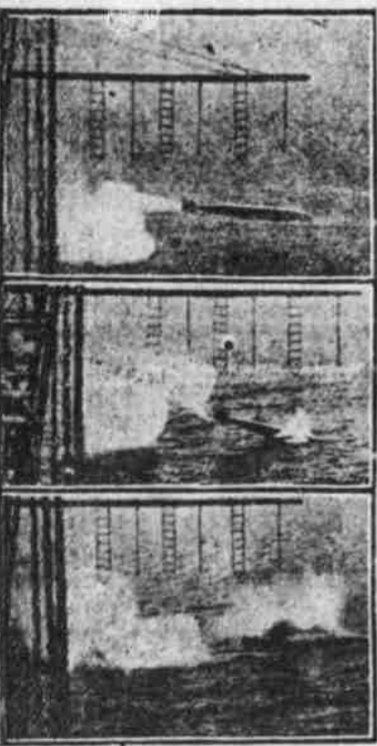

The Mikasa, Admiral Togo mustered aft the officers and crew and laid a small sword quietly, but significantly, on a whitewood tray, used for sacred purposes.

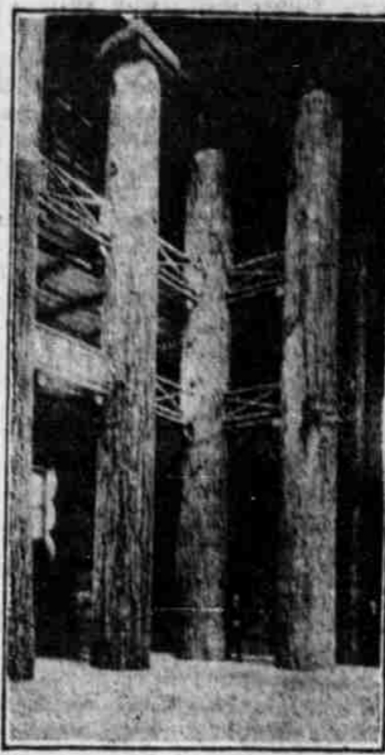
