Immediately after the escape of the lioness her trainer organized a hunting 15c, 2Oc, 25c, party of nearly 200 armed with guns and clubs. The animal was located several times and attempts were made by shooting and shouting to drive her toward her cage. Finally, after a chase lasting more than two hours the beast was ornered and driven back into her cage, which had been carried to the spot.
