New York, Nov. 14.—Little Louise Beatrice, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. John Chadwick, of Ninth avenue, had the distinction of being the principal of the first christening to occur on the Drake, the flagship of Prince Louis of Battenburg.

Louise Beatrice is six weeks old and she cried lustily all unconscious of the honor conferred on her both in the christening and in the fact that she was given the names of the two sisters of the King.

The christening was celebrated yesterday in the gun room of the six-inch amidship's guns on the starboard battery. Prince Louis was to have stood up as godfather but his Sunday was so full of social engagements that at the last moment he had to decline, and his Coxswain Albert Manns was godfather in his stead.

The great silver cup won by the crew of the Drake in a marksmanship contest served as the font and Chaplain Robinson of the ship officiated.
