#### WORD ORIGINS.

Old Meanings That Are New More or Less Obsolete,

"Many persons," says a college proessor, "elbow their way through the world and yet cannot tell why their wn elbows are so named. They forget that the syllable 'ell' was once our name for arm and then for a measure of an arm's length, a sense that is plain still in the proverb, 'Give an inch and he will take an ell.' In the light of this obsolete meaning 'elbow' is clearly ermbow, the bend of the arm. 'Finger' s allied to 'fang,' and so means a rasper, and 'hand' has a similar scuse because from the same root as 'hound,' the game grasper, and with apprehend.' 
