

San Francisco, Dec. 17 .- Mrs. Guaralupi Benamati, residing with her family at 2018 B Powell street, daughter of one of the most famous Mexican generals in the reign of Emperor Maximimillion, educated in the best conservatores of music in Europe and at one time a favorite of royalty, was taken into custody by special police in the Emporium yesterday evening on a charge of shoplifting.

The woman's suspicious actions attracted the attention of the clerks, and

a close watch was placed upon her. She was detected concealing articles in her clothing and when searched by Detectives Braig and Taylor, who were summoned to the store, the purloined goods were found in her possession. The woman, whose matronly appearance and stately mein indicated that she was anything but a petty thief, was led from the store to her place of residence. There the detectives found a hand

satchel filled with stolen goods. The articles consisted of ladies' garments and men's purses, chatelaine bags, toilet articles and necklaces of the probable value of \$50. The accused admitted her guilt. She will be held at the city prison without bail pending further investigation.

Mrs. Guarahipi Benamati was the daughter of General Mendosa, one of the most brilliant members of Emperor Maximillian's staff. Her father was also a prominent adviser to the throne of Mexico. 


