How to Grow Alfalfa.

Alfalfa must be reset every third year. I have been using cutaway her rows for resetting it along the Pacific coast for a great many years. The best method of resetting is to sow about ten pounds of new seed to the acre; then go over it with the cutaway harrow, set at a light angle, in both directions, split the heads of the old plants and reset with the new seed.
