NEW YORK, Nov. 2.—Burton Filedell, a resident of Mamoroneck, N. Y., committed suicide in the public square yesterday. Filedell rushed into a store and flourished a bottle of poison. He said excitedly, "It's all up with me. I am through. Good bye." Then he dashed out into the square, and while the villagers looked on, he swallowed two ounces of carbolic acid. He fell unconscious and was dead before a doctor could be called. Sudden insanity is believed to have been the cause of the suicide.

WAGES INCREASED.

Laborers in Butte Smelting Works Receive Increase.

BUTTE, Mont., Nov. 2.—In the East Helena smelters of the American Smelting and Refining company the wages of common laborers were raised today. About ninety per cent of the force is affected by the increase,

which will be about seven per cent. Men working a ten-hour shift, getting \$2 a day, will hereafter receive \$2.25; those under the 8-hour basis receiving \$2.25 to \$3.25, will get 15 cents more a day. The total increase will be about \$2,000 a month.

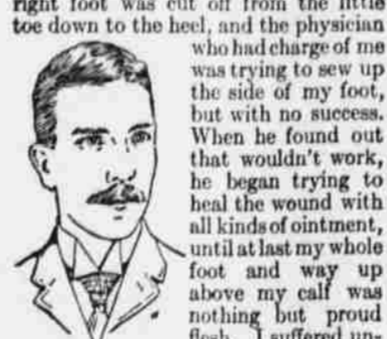
