FISHERMEN DROWNED.

Lost in a Severe Storm on Lake Michigan.
 CHICAGO, Nov. 6.—Three fishermen, Louis Wright, William Thornton and a man whose name could not be learned, who left Michigan City, Ind., on Saturday, in an open gasoline launch are believed to have been drowned. They were on their way to Chicago, giving the boat a test trip. They carried but little food, as they expected to make the trip in a short time.
 When they failed to reach Chicago it was at first believed that because of a small storm which swept the lake the men had beached the boat and were safe. The continued absence of the boat alarmed friends in Chicago and the life saving crews at South Chicago, Michigan City and St. Joseph, Mich., were notified. After an unsuccessful search all hope of finding the missing fishermen was abandoned last night. It is now believed that the boat was swamped by heavy seas after the fuel had been exhausted.
