a Baby Murder.

FOUND IN A BABY CARRIAGE

Body of Infant Found in a Baby Carrisge with a Walking Cane, Which Is Supposed to Figure in the Case.

NEW YORK, Dec. 1 .-- In the case of the child found in a baby carriage at 99th and Third avenue on Saturday evening, and believed to have been strangled, the police find themselves confronted by another murder case which will pass, in all probability, into the archives of unsolved mysteries. They now believe that the engraved walking cane in the carringe was another step in revenge on the part of a man who is supposed entirely cured." T. F. Laurin. to figure in the case. The child's clothes were of the cheapest materials, and some of them, mittens and raiters, for instance, were mismatched. They had been put on in a burry. On baby carriage was a handsome piece of wood, and decorated in rich, tasteful style.

The baby carriage was not new. One theory of the police is that the child here for abandonment.
