

CRITICISES CANAL METHODS.

Harriman Says Whole Trouble is Lack of Executive.

NEW YORK, March 2.—The World, in an interview with E. H. Harriman printed this morning quoted him as follows: "It is too bad that a man with such an alert mind as President Roosevelt has, should not have subjected himself to more discipline said Edward H. Harriman, during an interview on his cross-examination of the Interstate Commerce Commission. "Mr. Roosevelt is a very able man," he continued. "He is capable of doing things if there was only more fixity of purpose."

It was the day when announcement had been made of another change of purpose in Panama Canal affairs by order of the President.

"Why don't you build the canal?" Mr. Harriman was asked.

"I would if I had a chance," he replied. "Let me tell you this: We spend more money a year in improvements on the Union Pacific system than can be expended in any year on the canal. If we ran railroads like Panama canal affairs are conducted there would be a great crop of receiverships in this country."

"The whole trouble in Panama is lack of executive. How can you expect engineers to carry on work decently when it is impossible to get a decision on important points from headquarters until three or four weeks.

"You must have an executive head in every department, an executive with a fixed purpose in view. You must have such a system as will enable any part of it to have an immediate and firm decision when any question arises. Then it can be done."

REORGANIZING POLICE.

Morocco Will Have Three Detachments at Each Port.

MADRID, March 2.—In accordance with the Franco-Spanish agreement signed Thursday, the organization of the police force is to be as follows:

There are to be three detachments of police at each port, two detachments under one officer will protect the harbor and town, while the third, under another officer, will guard the suburbs. In the mixed ports such as Tangier, the commanders of the two sections must be of different nationality. In the event of the necessity for united action the officer with the highest rank will command all three detachments. A water police for the prevention of the passage of contraband will also be organized.

Should Franco-Spanish intervention become necessary at any point it is to be conducted on lines similar to those followed during the recent naval demonstration at Tangier.

DISTURBS STOCK MARKET.

Harriman Investigation Leads to Thoughts of Retrenchment.

NEW YORK, March 2.—The Harriman investigation has been the principal disturbing influence in the stock market this week. Facts disclosed were not generally new to Wall Street, but the probable effect on the agitation for more stringent government control of corporations and on the public demand for both foreign and domestic securities has been much dreaded. The increase of capital requirements and the necessity of retrenchment of plans for railroad improvements to conform to capital limitations, occupy a large share of attention. Trade and industrial reports show no signs of contraction. Money was firmer with the March settlements, but the passage of the Aldrich bill increased confidence in the money outlook.
