REORGANIZING POLICE.

Morocco Will Have Three Detachments at Each Port.

MADRID, March 2.-In accordance with the Franco-Spanish agreement signed Thursday, the organization of the police force is to be as follows:

There are to be three detatchments of police at each port, two detatchments under one officer will protect the harbor and town, while the third, under another officer, will guard the suburbs. In the mixed ports such as Tangler, the commanders of the two sections must be of different nationality. In the event of the necessity for united action the officer with the highest rank will command all three detachments. A water police for the prevention of the passage of contraband will also be organized.

Should Franco-Spanish intervention become necessary at any point it is to be conducted on lines similar to those followed during the recent naval demonstration at Tangler.


