THE SEPARATOR.

If Properly Handled It Will Prove a Splendid Investment.

Every progressive dairyman should have a hand separator. You can then give the calves fresh sweet skim milk. It is expensive to feed calves on whole milk, especially when you can sell the butter for 25 cents per pound and supply the fat taken from the milk by oil meal or oil cake at a few cents per pound.

From the other side, the separator is certainly a splendid investment as a labor saver. It is also valuable as a means of getting all the butter fat from the milk. Get a good standard machine, but don't get a very small size unless you have only a very few cows. For ten to twelve cows we would certainly recommend a 450 to 650 pound per hour separator.

Cleaning the Machine.

Wash the machine every time it is used. Don't believe the agent who tells you that you can wash his machine by simply dipping the parts in warm water. Any one who has handled vessels in which milk has been kept knows that that is not so. Use a brush, not a dish rag, to wash each piece of the separator; then pour boiling hot water over the parts and allow to dry.

Use plenty of oil on the bearings, and thus greatly increase the life of the machine. Fasten the separator securely to the floor, take three minutes to speed it up, heat up the bowl with a little lukewarm water before separating, then flush out with a little clean water after the milk has run through to get all the cream.—Professor W. J. Elliott.

Chilaian Volcano Devastates Territory Causing Great Amage.

LIMA, Peru, April 19.—The volcano Puyehu in the province of Valdivia, Chili, is yet in active eruption and new offices have developed and opened. RECORDED IN LONDON.

Delicate Instruments Record the Mexican Earthquake in London.

LONDON, April 19.—John M. Milne, the seismologist, says that his instruments recorded a large earthquake beginning at 9:10 Wednesday night. It reached its maximum in tenity at 10:05 and lasted a long time. He tentatively estimates that it was 5400 miles distant, probably in Mexico, or the northern part of South America. Professor Delar of Lacibach, Austria observatory, telegraphs that a great earthquake began at 10:15 midnight, European time. The centre of the disturbance was, apparently, 6,250 miles away.

CUBAN PROTECTORATE.

General Gomez Declares Cuba Does Not Want a Tutor.

HAVANA, April 19.—General Jose Miguel Gomez, who is a candidate for the presidency of Cuba, in a published interview said that the re-established republic will not fall again. He said: "It will be different from the first experiment in that the law will be respected and upheld with an iron hand. Complaisance is a good thing but not when it is misdirected. The sell of a republic the liberals will maintain, will not fall. We will respect the law."

"The elections will be honest. I think the Cubans unaided possess full ability to maintain this republic to which we look forward. We desire no strengthening of the Taft amendment such as the conservatives request and unless the Americans fall short in their promises the republic will be re-established on the same lines as the first. "Cuba wants no protectorate. What is intended by the word has not been defined but clearly the result would be tutelage. Cuba does not need a tutor."
