

Night Expedition to Test Vigilence of Harbor Forts.

REPULSED FOREIGN SHIPS

Imaginary Foreign Fleet Composed of United States Vessels Try To Get Into New York's Inner Harbor But Were Discovered by Powerful Searchlights,

NEW YORK, June 11 .- The coast artillery at Fort Wadsworth, and Fort Hamilton, which guard the narrows, were more or less on the qui vive last night. Word reached them that, theoretically, a fleet of foreign warships had been sighted in the lower bay and that an attempt would be made by the ves-sels to steal into the harbor at dead of night and attack the city. All this means that the War Department is affording the forts a new experience testing the vigilance and activity of the garrisons. The so-called foreign fleet is really a detachment of torpedo planters and dispatch boats under command of Captain G. T. Patterson of the coast artillery. He is instructed to try to creep up past the forts and enter the inner harbor at any time up to Thursday. While the men in the range towers in the forts were playing searchlights upon the water about 8:30 last night three of the attacking boats were discovered attempting to steal on the narrows at a distance of about a thousand yards from Fort Hamilton. As soon as the lights were turned on them
