## SALVADOR INVADED

Government Troops Drive Invaders to the Coast.

### FRISCO MAN IN THE SCRAP

Reported On Good Authority That the Troops Are Ready To Invade Salvador From Three Sides—Troops On Honduran Border Ready To Enter.

MEXICO CITY, June 12.—According to a telegram received in this city late tonight the Salvadoran army has defeated the invading army which captured the Port of Acahula yesterday and has driven them back to the coast. One of the leaders of the invading army was John Moissant, a former resident of San Francisco and an American citizen. He is reported to have been captured by the forces of President Figueroa. It is reported on good authority that troops are ready to invade Salvador from three sides. According to this information, Generals Toledo and Alfara are on the Honduran border ready to strike.

### CONVENTION OF CREDIT MEN.

CHICAGO, June 12.—Several hundred credit men from all parts of the United States, delegates to the twelfth annual meeting of the National Association, will gather in Chicago today. Two sessions will be held daily. Governor Denen and Mayor Busee, on behalf of the state and city will welcome delegates to Chicago.

The convention will close with a banquet on Friday evening. Among the addresses will be Speaker Joseph Cannon, George B. Peck, Levy Mayer and Judge Grosscup.

### NEW METROPOLITAN CONDUCTOR.

NEW YORK, June 12.—A cable from Vienna received at the Metropolitan Opera House from Director Coureid announced that he has engaged Gustav Mahler, the noted Viennese conductor for next season.
