TRIES TO ESCAPE

Old Geronimo Would Join His People

ESCAPES BUT IS RECAPTURED

He Heard of the Recent Troubles of The Indians in Arizona—Is Having Family Troubles And Has Taken To Drinking.

CHICAGO, July 9.—A dispatch to the Tribune from Cache, Okla., says:—The old Apache warrior Geronimo who terrorized the Southwest for many years with his bloodthirsty band, while attending a celebration at Cache under parole as the guest of the Commanche Chief, Quanah Parker, made an attempt to escape across the Texas panhandle into New Mexico.

Geronimo was missed from the Indian camp for about eight hours and a detail of soldiers from Fort Sill captured him several miles out of Cache yesterday.

The old warrior had heard of the trouble to reports have threatened to go on the war path. The Chief says he wanted to go with his people and help them fight.

He has been having family troubles lately, his eighth wife, having left him. Recently he drank liquor to excess and lay out on the reservation all night. This incensed the church-going people. Geronimo recently joined the Dutch Reformed church to which President Roosevelt belongs, in the hope, it is said, of obtaining a pardon.

THREE MEN DROWNED.

NEW YORK, July 8.—New York Central Tug No. 18 while running in the North River off Weehawken early this morning ran across a small capsized yacht and four men struggling in the water. The men were rescued. The men told the captain that the yachting party had consisted of seven men three of whom had been drowned. The yacht was the Yacana owned by W. C. Pierce.

HARGIS ON TRIAL.

Once More He Will Face Jury On Charge of Assassination.

SANDY HOOK, Ky., July 9.—After traveling part of the journey on foot, Special Judge W. E. Moody of Eminence, arrived here last night and today will call the cases of Judge James Hargis and others charged with procuring the assassination of Dr. B. D. Cox at Jackson four years ago.

It is almost certain that one or more of the cases will be tried at this term. Although it has been known for several weeks that the cases would be called at this time, no witnesses for either side have been summoned, but Judge Moody will give both defense and prosecution time to summon witnesses and it is likely that when the case is called to-day court will adjourn until witnesses can be summoned.

The case of Judge Hargis will be the first to be tried. All of Hargis' faction are in the city. He preceded Judge Moody who came with Attorney Floyd Byrd and T. P. Carnwell, brother-in-law of Dr. Cox.

MANSFIELD RECOVERING.

NEW YORK, July 9.—Richard Mansfield, the actor who has been seriously ill, in a letter to friends in this city from Sussex, England, announced that he was well on the road to recovery. But he confirmed recent statements that he would not act this year, saying he would obey the physicians' orders and avoid all exertion and excitement.
