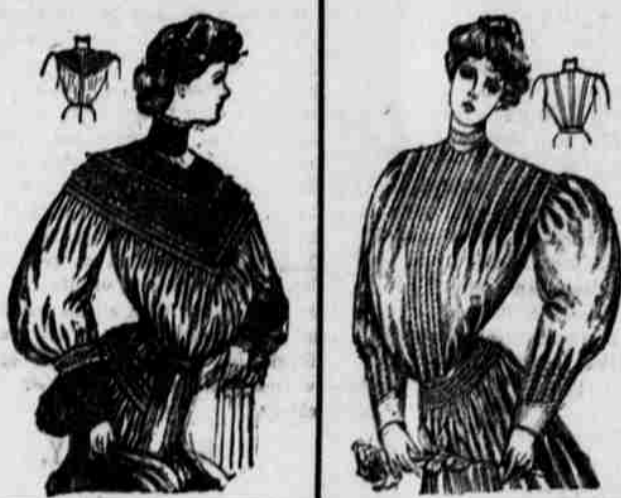

STRIKE UNAUTHORIZED.
Locals Suspended and Support Withheld by United Garment Workers.

NEW YORK, July 22.—The United Garment Workers of America, to which the Brotherhood of Tailors which ordered the present series of strikes of coat tailors, belong, has declared the strike unauthorized and suspended the locals of the Brotherhood which ordered them. This action deprives 35,000 tailors now

on strike of all support from the United Garment Workers or the American Federation of Labor. The executive committee of striking tailors decided to continue the strike in spite of their suspension.

INDUSTRIAL PEACE

Conference to be Held at San Francisco

CABINET MEMBERS TO ATTEND

Oscar Strauss, Secretary of Commerce and Labor, and James R. Garfield, Secretary of Interior, Will Make Addresses—Conference Will End July 25

SAN FRANCISCO, July 22.—An industrial peace conference will convene in this city tomorrow morning. Two members of President Roosevelt's cabinet will deliver addresses at Wednesday's session of the conference. Oscar Strauss, secretary of Commerce and Labor will speak in the forenoon on "The National Civic Federation," of which he is vice-president, and in the afternoon, James R. Garfield, Secretary of the Interior, will give a general talk on industrial peace.

Wednesday, the second day of the conference, will be devoted entirely to the discussion of the subject, "How Industrial Peace May Be Maintained With Justice to Employer and Wage-Earner."
The conference will end on Thursday.

JAPANESE AUTOIST.

K. Okura, Son of Steel King of Japan, Buys Automobiles.

NEW YORK, July 22.—K. Okura, son of the steel king of Japan, who has been studying at Cambridge, has arrived here from Europe with four of the swiftest automobiles he could buy in the London market. They are mostly of French make, and he is going to take them home to Japan via San Francisco and show his countrymen how to drive a car.

Okura had a secretary and a retinue of servants.
At a recent race in England he arranged with Wagner, the expert chauffeur, to drive his car. Wagner hurt his arm at the last minute and could not drive. The little Japanese jumped in

and made the race as owner and driver, finishing second.

KIDNAPS OWN CHILD.

Tore Child From Mother's Arms In Broad Daylight Causing Excitement.

GREAT FALLS, Mont., July 22.—C. M. Stubbs, a well known resident of Stanford, yesterday kidnapped his two-year-old child from its mother in the main business street of this city in broad daylight and at a time when that thoroughfare was crowded. The greatest excitement resulted. Stubbs was assisted by Maurice Roosa, a friend who drove up as Stubbs tore the child from its screaming mother and rapidly bore it away, pursued by a wrathful crowd bent on summarily punishing the kidnapper. Stubbs was arrested.

JEWISH CONFERENCE.

Will Be Held in Carnegie Hall, New York Next October.

NEW YORK, July 22.—Delegates from all the Hebrew organizations in the United States will be invited to attend the meeting in Carnegie Hall next October to establish an international Jewish conference. Arrangements to this end have been made by the executive committee of which Dr. Julius Weise is chairman. It is expected that

fully 2000 delegates will attend.

A. S. Schomer is the promoter and president of the organization which is to act as a bond of union for the Hebrews of the world. It is proposed to call the body the International Congress of All Israel. One of the advantages urged is that it would be able to act authoritatively in case of oppression or massacre and be entitled to recognition from the Czar of Russia or any other ruler. International headquarters possibly will be in London.

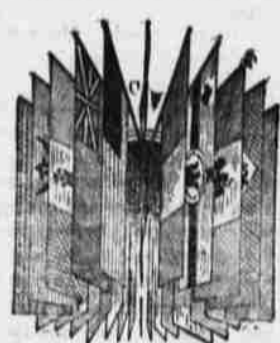
