Japan Acted With Great Moderation in Matter

The Forced Abdication Was Discussed Long Before the War Between Russia and Japan-Japan Considered Entitled to the Fruits of War.

CHICAGO, July 22 .- A dispatch to the Tribune from Washington says: It is the opinion of diplomats here hat after the first natural disturbances are quelled, Korea will be much the gainer for the actual transfer of its ontrol to the Japanese. For a generaion Korea has been disturbed with all sorts of feuds. The Emperor, who was just deposed, and his two sons have manifested a complete incapacity for the science of government. Long before the war between Japan and Russia it was evident to every student of Oriental affairs that Korea was destined to be wiped off the map and that too at no distant period. Oriental students say it was much better for Korea that the change of sovereignty should be to the Japanese and not to some European nation. The Japanese are affiliated with the Koreans in a thousand different ways and the two nations amalgamate a great deal more certainly than if the Emperor of Korea had been forced to abdicate in favor of a Caucasion govern-

All reports indicate that the Japanese acted with great moderation. They planned to take over Korea at the outset of the war with Russia. The forced abdication of the Emperor was discussed a ong while ago. There has been a practical understanding for nearly a year between all the great powers that Japan Toilet Articles. was entitled to the fruits of victory in Korea, as it was evident that the antiquated empire could not possibly main tain itself.

CUBAN JOAN OF ARC.

Death of Famous Woman of Cuba at Ago of 70 Years.

NEW JULY, July 22.—Cable advices from Havana, Cuba, announce the death of Senora Juan Quesada, the Cuban Joan of Arc, at the age of 70 years.

Senora Quesada was the best known woman in the island. She came of a good family but despite the comforts and luxury which her circumstances gave her, she chose to aid her countrymen in the field and wielded a machete in the en years' struggle against Spain, but her bravery and the standing of her family made her the best known.

Patrick S. Gilmore, who in those lays conducted the Twenty-second Regiment band at Manhattan Beach often publicly honored the woman patriot by playing the Cuban national hymn whenever Senora Quesada was in the audience.
