

### A HIT AT PRESIDENT

Socialist Leader Reflects on Roosevelt.

### "AN UNDESIRABLE CITIZEN"

Socialist Leader and Editor Jubilant Over Haywood Trial—Mass Meeting for Haywood.

NEW YORK, July 29.—"President Roosevelt," not W. D. Haywood is now the "undesirable citizen."

So said Alexander Jonas, socialist leader and editor of the Volks Zeitung when asked how he liked the acquittal of Haywood. His reply was more pronounced than the many opinions by the local socialists and organized labor leaders, but jubilation was the key note of them all. Mr. Oppenheimer, the organizer of the Moyer-Haywood conference speaking at the meeting of the Central Federated Union in which socialist and non unions are represented said:

"I have been a great many years in the labor business and in all my life this is the first time the working class has exerted itself the same way as it has done in behalf of these men," meaning Haywood, Moyer and Pettibone. Efforts will be made to persuade Haywood to come here next week to attend a Socialist parade and mass meeting in his honor to be held in Madison Square Garden. It is expected that 50,000 persons will be in the parade. The New York Socialists have been the first to come to the aid of Haywood, Moyer and Pettibone. They contributed \$25,000 of the \$100,000 raised for the defense.

### JAPAN'S NEW PRIMER.

SEATTLE, July 29.—K. Sugiura, a representative of the Hochi Shimbun, of Tokio, is here. He predicts the overthrow of the Saionji ministry. He declared that the people of Japan are almost a unit in their opposition to the present ministry and that before the next elections, in September, the followers of Saionji will have lost their political heads.

"Either Adiral Yamamoto, or Count Katsura will be the next premier of Japan," said Mr. Sugiura. "The present ministry has made many blunders. The lack of skilful diplomacy in the San Francisco incident, I believe, is largely instrumental in causing so much talk. There is no thought of war in Japan. We will never forget what the Americans have done for us," he said.

### ANGRY ELEPHANT

A Vicious Tusker Almost Kills Keeper.

HE TAKES MAN FOR THIEF

Gunda Thinks Hoffman About to Rob Him of Hoard of Pennies—Tries to Snatch Him Into Cage But is Saved by Fellow-Keeper.

NEW YORK, July 29.—Gunda, an elephant in the Bronx park Zoological gardens which amuses crowds by picking up tents thrown him and carefully hoarding them, all but killed a man he believed was trying to rob him. The man is Otto Hoffman, a keeper.

Hoffman has had 15 years experience with wild animals, but had been Gunda's keeper for only a week, but was evidently ignorant of the elephant's idiosyncrasies. He was on the point of picking up a cent which had rolled out of the reach of Gunda's trunk when the animal flew into a rage, grabbed him and dragged him into the cage. By clinging to the elephant's tusks the keeper managed to keep himself from trodden to death. Other keepers prodded the animal with pitchforks until Hoffman could get out of the cage. When he did so he fainted. A doctor found the man was badly bruised and had a crushed rib and a bruised liver. He is in a serious way.
