LOOT HOTEL RUINS

Ashes at Long Beach Prove to be Gold Mine.

ARRESTS MADE FOR STEALING

Waiters of Rhode Island Resort Fined Costly Ornaments in Ruins But Are Caught With Goods On-More Men Search This Afternoon.

NEW YORK, July 30 .- A feature of the fire which destroyed the mammoth Long Beach Hotel, and in which nearly a thousand guests were driven out in the sand in scant attire has just developed. In their hurried flight the guests abandoned money, jewelry, and other valuable property, and looters, it appears, were quick to take advantage of the fact. Detectives who were sent to the scene arrested three colored waiters and a Greek laborer and stolen property, it is stated, was found in their possession. The men were held on a charge of grand larceny.

Justice Wallace, who gave the bond looters a hearing, was informed that the thieves had buried stolen property in the sand dunes back of the hotel site and he ordered men out to make a search. The amount of property they recovered was surprising. Wherever there was a sign that the sand had been recently disturned excavations were made and something brought to light. By dark the justice had in his pos-ession several trunks full of stuff, bags, satchels, bundles, and boxes containing valuables. He had rings and pins and stickpinwatches and chains and a great collection of all sorts of jeweled combs and silver backed toilet articles and some dresses and suits.

When it became too dark for further search, a guard was set over the property. All property owners will be kept from the vicinity. More men will be put to work this afternoon on another search of the ruins.

ALASKA TO HAVE WIRELESS.

NEW YORK, July 30 .- The United States government has let a contract to the United States Steel Corporation for transmission towers which are to be utilized for wireless telegraph service in Alaska.
