

ROSSA NO COWARD

New York Policeman is Cleared From Disgrace.

BINGHAM IN STIRRING SPEECH

Tells Blue-Coats That There Must be no Cowardice in the Force and That Record for Thirty Years Must be Maintained.

NEW YORK, July 31.—Policeman Tracy L. Rossa, one of the two policemen placed on trial on a charge of cowardice in connection with the escape of murderer Frank Warner, has been acquitted of the charge. He proved that there was no blemish on his character as charged and the case was dismissed. The trial of Policeman Stephen Walsh, who was similarly accused, will be resumed today.

Police Commissioner Bingham took occasion after his acquittal, to make a stirring speech regarding courage to the 50 or more policemen in attendance in the trial room. He said: "You men all know that we cannot

stand for any white feather or any yellow streaks or any cowardice on this force, and we don't have to. Almost without exception for 30 years there has not been proved a charge of cowardice against any man on this force, and it is the duty of everyone of you men to see that proud record carried out."

WASHINGTON TIMBER BURNS.

Unless Rain Falls Great Tract of Forest Will be Destroyed.

TACOMA, July 31.—A Bellingham special to the Ledger says:

A fire, which threatened to do thousands of dollars of damage is raging in the timber north of Birdview, Skagit County, and unless a soaking rain comes soon, millions of feet of standing timber will be burned. This fire has been burning for some days and now presents a front of fire four miles wide and is rapidly sweeping up from the valley of the Skagit river northward and nothing but rain will prevent its traveling across the divide to the South fork of the Nooksack, a distance of eight miles.

AMERICAN MACHINES.

Automobilists Will Compete for Cup in American Cars in Florida.

NEW YORK, July 31.—Now that the Vanderbilt cup race for automobiles has been abandoned, there is talk of holding an automobile race exclusively for American cars. At a meeting of the executive committee of the American Automobile Association, unanimous sentiment in favor of such a race was expressed. If it is decided to have such a race it will be held at Ormonde Beach, Fla., probably next March.

An automobile convention will be held in this city during the automobile show from October 24 to November 7. Papers will be read and discussions held on practical motor topics, such as legislation, good roads, touring facilities and other features. Motorists will be required to be present from all parts of the country and give their views on these subjects.
