## DIAMONDS ADVANCE

English Trust Controls Out-Put and Markets.

## HIGH AND ADVANCING LEVEL

So Stated To Be The Intention Of The Trust In Regard To Prices Of The Carbon Sparklers—Takes Over All The Big South African Mines.

NEW YORK, Aug. 12.—Messages received from London, by brokers in the last few days say that the absorption of the Premier Mines by the DeBeers Diamond Trust, already reported, was only one of a number of developments as a result of which the big companies control the business in all parts of the world is now said to be absolutely controlled by De Beers.

Besides getting control of the Premier mine, the trust has closed contracts under which it will take for a term of years the output of the two other independent mines, the Voorspoed and the Roberts Victor.

One of the largest of the Maiden Lane importers said that there is now no possibility of any serious competition. The trust, he said, was following the policy of maintaining the market at a high and advancing level.

## MARINE TRAGEDY.

Nicaraguan Is So Long Overdue That She Has Been Given Up For Lost.

NEW YORK, Aug. 12.—No word having been received regarding the British freight steamer Nicaraguan since she passed the Virginian capes on June 8, hope for her safety has been given up at Dublin, where she should have arrived not later than June 22.

The Nicaraguan is one of the Leyland fleet, a part of the international marine, and steamed out of port Tampa on June 3. She put into Norfolk five days later for bunker coal and passed out of the capes the same day.

Captain Shackelock and a crew of 140 men were aboard the Nicaraguan. She was heavily laden with phosphate rock, and it is feared, she was run down by an iceberg, the steel steamer would have floated only a few moments after the crash.

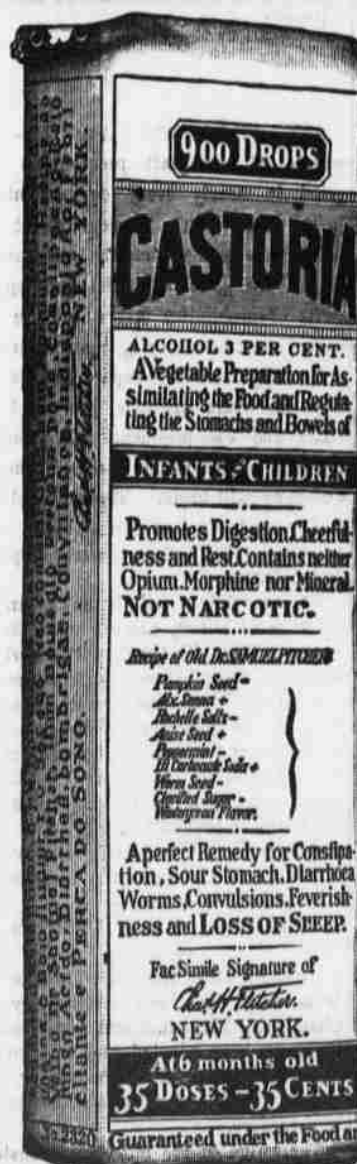
