

EASTWARD FREIGHT

Much Time Will be Saved by Athol Cut Off.

Union Pacific Railroad Is Undertaking Work Which Will Save In Time And Rate On All Eastbound Freight-Great Engineering Problem.

NEW YORK, Aug. 14:-Following the resumption of work on the building of its Athol Hill cut off, south of Cheyenne. the Union Pacific Railroad has aunounced the details of this important improvement, which will result in considerable saving of time on the Pacific Coast through freight to Denver and eastern points. Construction of this line will also relieve the congestion of the Cheyenne yards.

Starting on the main line of the Union Pacific between Denver and Cheyenne near Carr, Colorado, the new cut-off runs northeast to Borie, Wyoming, connecting with the main line through Wyoming nine and a half miles west of Cheyenne. A branch leaves the main stem between Carr and Borie three miles south of Corlett, connecting with the Wyoming division four and a half miles west of Cheyenne. The total length of the new lines under construction is 17 miles. and the saving in distance between Denver and Borie and points west by way of the main stem of the cut off is over 13 miles.

The maximum grade on the present line between Carr and Cheyenne is 1.8 per cent in both directions. This grade by the new line is cut down to 1.2 per cent north or westbound, with no adverse grades south or east. The troublesome curves of the present line are also avoided. It is expected to have the cut off completed and in operation be fore the end of the year.

Two hundred and twenty thousand ubic yards of roadbed excavation, about 30,000 yards of which is solid rock, and 900,000 cubic yards of embankment, are avolved in the building of the cut-off. The largest fill is 2700 feet long and 45 feet high. Bridging on the new line consists of concrete arches, east from iron pipe culverts and three-pile trestles of 5, 8 and 10 spans. The longest arch is 135 feet. Three new stations will be located along the line to serve local traffic of which there is very little outside of cattle shipments.
