RAILWAY ON MEXICAN SOIL.

LOS ANGELES, Sept. 5.—Tomorrow morning Assistant Chief Engineer J. E. Carrillo, of the Southern Pacific, will leave with a large force to rush to completion the company's new line from Calexico to Yuma, through Mexican territory. Because of the Colorado river's outbreak two years ago, work has been suspended while the railroad conquered the mighty stream with a gigantic dam and dyke system.

This line was designed to avoid the forbidding desert through which passengers to and from California are now carried. By going below the international boundary they will be carried around the forbidding stretch and its discomforts through land that is already beginning to blossom under irrigation. The road will run thirty miles over the million acre ranch of the California-Mexico Land and Cattle Company.

FEARS NO OUTBREAK.

HONOLULU, Sept. 5.—K. Ishii, secretary of the Bureau of Commerce of the Japanese Foreign Office, who is now in the United States as a special commissioner of his government, has written Consul Saito saying that he believes there will be no further outbreak of anti-Japanese sentiment in San Francisco. He adds that he hopes to succeed in amicably adjusting the present difficulties.

JAPAN THE POWER

Which Rules Corea and China
—Says Senator Stone.

SUPPORTS ALL TRADE SCHEMES

There is no Resentment Among Japanese Towards This Country on Account of Recent Troubles and Mikado Was Particularly Friendly Towards Visitors.

SAN FRANCISCO, Sept. 6.—United States Senator, W. J. Stone, who returned from a journey to the islands and the Orient yesterday by the liner Hongkong Maru, says that the whole face of the east has changed during the last few years.

"The Japanese," says the Senator, "have taken entire control of affairs both in China and Corea, and have so systemized commercial and political undertakings in the east that in a short time all European and American influence will be completely shut out."

Senator Stone, who was accompanied on his trip by his wife and daughter, left Vancouver on May 1st with ex-Senator Charles A. Tamm. Both gentlemen were members of the Senate Committee on the Philippines, and made a most exhaustive study of conditions in these islands.

In Japan Senator Stone was an honored guest of the Emperor. The Mikado, during the Senator's audience, made no reference to the relations existing between Japan and America.

Outside of court circles Senator Stone found that there was among a certain small class a spirit of resentment at the reported ill treatment of Japanese in San Francisco. The bulk of the people, however, expressed nothing but the best of feeling toward this country.

On all hands the unpreparedness of Japan for war was admitted, and nothing was supposed to be more unlikely than a quarrel with the United States.

With regard to commercial undertakings Senator Stone states that Japan is putting forth herculean efforts to seize trade. The government is willing to back every commercial enterprise of importance, both in a direct manner by cash subsidies and also indirectly by freight concessions on the government railroads. This backing only extends to Japanese firms operating in China, Japan and Corea, and will have the effect in a very limited time of absolutely killing all European and American trade.

"Japan," says the Senator, "will rule the Orient. There will be no room for any other nation."

NEW ALASKAN PEAK.

SAN FRANCISCO, Sept. 5.—Returning after several months of research in the Far North, Dr. C. Eakle and A. B. Myers, members of an expedition which left Seattle last year in the schooner Lydia to inquire into the formation of Perry Island, arrived here this morning on the steamer Homer.

During their stay in Alaskan waters the two scientists were treated to another phenomenon when a new peak, which has since been named McCulloch Peak, was found.

By the formation of this new peak Perry Island has been transformed into a peninsula, being connected with the Bogoslog Islands, according to those of the expedition who arrived on the Homer.

The whole formation is steaming hot and several earthquakes, due to the volcanic disturbances which preceded the advent of McCulloch Peak, were felt by both Dr. Eakle and his companion.
