It must be the product of condilions not found in the average American city and rightly classed as abnormal. <br> We are entering an era, I bellieve, when the former derision of our govermmental efforts to regulate corporations will be forgotten by the successful regulation of these corporations by properly constituted authorities. Backed by well-defined and earnest sentiment there is no ground to fear that any law or set of laws will not be rigidy enforeed. <br> In the past the method towaris regulation have been crude and ineffective because both people and officials recognized the crudeness. New methods are being perfected and the support of the boly politio assures thoruogh execution. A publio service corporation under statutes such as exist in New York and Wisconsin is absolutely at the murey of agents of the law, equipped with adequate devices to secure obedience. The capital invested in these corporations does not wish to be devourcal in whole br in part. The only other alternative lies in treating the public fairly in the matter of prices and service and living up to the law. This plan certainly is sounder and more apt to produce the |
