UNION OF REPUBLICS

Central American Countries Under One Flag.

ZELAYA WOULD RESIGN OFFICE

Guatemala, Salvador, Honduras, Costa Rica and Nicaragua to be Amalgamated Into the Central American Republic—Governments Are Communicating.

NEW YORK, Nov. 14.—On the eve of the assembling of the Central American Peace Conference, Dr. Fernando Sanchez, minister of Nicaragua to Mexico, who is in this city, has made public an official communication which he addressed to Ignacio Mariscal, minister of foreign affairs of Mexico, on the Union of Central American republics. Senor Sanchez not only expresses the desire of his government that these five republics shall be merged into one nation and places President Zelaya of Nicaragua, on record as in favor of it, but goes so far as to say the latter is ready to resign his office. The last declaration will surprise everybody conversant with Central American politics as President Zelaya, who has held his office a dozen years, has been regarded as the chief trouble maker in Central America from whom only death or revolution could take away his despotic powers. Now he appears as the leading advocate of peace and fraternity.

Senor Sanchez in his letter says: "The government of Nicaragua has given me instructions to lay before you the firm resolve with which it is animated to have Central America, by the voluntary and pacific acts of its governments, conformed into one nation. The president, General Don Jose Santos Zelaya, who has ever been an unwavering partisan of this patriotic idea and one of the most persistent fighters for its realization, is disposed—as he ever has been—to resign with pleasure the office which he occupies in Nicaragua in favor of whatever citizen may be elected by the people as president of the Central American Republic.

"If your government thinks well of it, my government would be pleased to have communications sent to the governments of Guatemala, Salvador, Honduras, and Costa Rica, informing them of the firm and patriotic resolution of President Zelaya, so that should it meet with their approbation they might give ample powers to their representatives to act thereon."

THE SNEEZE

The boys seized the rope and tugged for dear life. Just as the schoolmaster reached the top of the well he sneezed. The boys let go the rope and clapped their hands, shouting, "Long live our noble master!" As for the poor schoolmaster, he fell to the bottom of the well, where he may be to this day, for all one knows.—Milwaukee Wisconsin.
