## BEATS OWN RECORD

**Sixty-Nine Year Old Pedestrian Finishes Long Walk.**

## MEETS WITH ENTHUSIASM

**Weston Walked the Same Course Forty Years Ago—Many Old-Timers Who Turned Out to See Him Then Greet Him When he Finishes.**

**CHICAGO, Nov. 26.**—Edward Payson Weston, 69 years old, eschaduled to walk into Chicago at 4 p. m. today, or there abouts, at the rate of five miles an hour, and complete, at the steps of the New Illinois Athletic Club, a record breaking walk of 1,230 miles from Portland, Maine, begun October 29.

If Weston finishes his walk as arranged and there is every chance that he will, for at two o'clock this morning he was resting at Chesterton, Ind., but 40 miles away he will have done what he set out to do and beaten the record established by himself 40 years ago, when, in his prime as a pedestrian, he was one of the champion walkers of the world.

His record for the distance made when he was 29 years of age was 26 secular days, for Weston never walks on Sunday. If he finishes his performance in Chicago this afternoon, he will have beaten the record of his young days by several hours.

According to the dispatches sent out from towns at which he has touched along the route, Weston has been getting faster rather than slower, in his promenade for many days past. For some time he was troubled with acute indigestion, which hampered his speed. Of late however, he has been in perfect physical condition, and has been reeling off the miles at the rate of five per hour with as little apparent trouble as the average broker negotiates the distance between the club and the motor car at the curb.

The New Illinois Athletic Club will have a reception committee in automobiles at South Chicago to greet Weston when he hits that part of the route. There also will be a detachment of the First Regiment, in which a guard of honor and a bugle corps.

Not the least interesting part of the throng that will greet Weston will be the old timers who cheered him when he entered Chicago 40 years ago. There are thousands of men still living who were present when Weston came down Michigan Avenue on Nov. 28, 1867, whipping his muscles to further activity with a short "swagger" stick which he carried. Among the features of the reception will be the appearance of Alderman Mangier at Michigan avenue and 22nd St. driving a "one horse shay" exactly the same vehicle as was used in 1867 by S. D. McGuire, Sr., when he drove to welcome Weston.

The long hike of Weston was begun on October 29, when he left the postoffice at Portland bearing a letter to be delivered at the postoffice in Chicago to be postmaster or his representative. Westons schedule called for his arrival here Nov. 27 but he has consistently kept ahead of the schedule. If he reaches the city this afternoon he will beat the record of 1867 by nearly 24 hours.

Weston has met with a good deal of difficulty on the present trip because of muddy roads, but in spite of that handicap he has steadily maintained his advantage over the demands of his schedule. The only advantage the pedestrian has in his present attempt in comparison with the walk when he was a young man is that the roads on the average are much better now than they were then over the route traversed.

During the entire trip Weston had met with much enthusiasm along the route, towns turning out en masse to greet him.

It is stated that Weston intends to make a lecture out of his experiences on the present trip. He has already done a considerable amount of lecture work and is declared to have made a success of it. Weston is a most enthusiastic believer in the virtues of walking, which he pronounces a cure-all for the ills of humanity.

Weston's walk of 40 years ago ended on November 27, the date of departure from Portland being the same as on the present attempt. He reached Chicago in the morning and it was estimated that he was welcomed by a throng of 50,000 persons, who cheered his pluck and persistence to the echo. The occasion largely took on the nature of a public holiday, and many shops closed so that the employes might take part in the reception.

His arrival in Chicago on that occasion was the final to a walk which had interested almost the entire country.

## GROWS VEGETABLES IN ALASKA.

Remarkable Crop Raised On Farm of Three Acres Near Fairbanks.

**SEATTLE, Nov. 26.**—If the Alaska Yukon-Pacific Exposition which will be held in 1909 should offer a prize for the best plot of ground under cultivation in Alaska or Yukon, Fred Gerhardt of Fairbanks, who has recently sent to the Exposition management details of the crop gathered from his three acres, would stand a good chance of winning honorable mention.

Indeed it is doubtful if Pacific Coast farmers who have the advantage of being three thousand miles nearer the equator, could better Gerhardt's record. On his three acres outside of Fairbanks last summer he grew ten tons of turnips, four tons of rutabagas, 8000 heads of celery, five tons of cabbages and several dozen tons of mixed vegetables including carrots, beets, lettuce, radishes, tomatoes, parsley, mushrooms and cucumbers.

Gerhardt will make some six to eight thousand dollars clear off his three acres, and there are many Alaskan miners who have not done so well the past season. The Alaska-Yukon-Pacific Exposition will demonstrate through exhibits from farms such as Gerhardt's that gold is not the only wealth that can be gathered out of the ground of the country of the Circle.
