BURIED BESIDE SPOUSE. Woman Who Murdered Her Husband Interred by Him.

NEW YORK, Nov. 27.—The body of Mrs. Grace Smith, the woman of mystery, who murdered her husband and then killed herself at New Rochelle, will be buried beside that of her husband in Baltimore. This has been decided by Smith's brother, who is here from Baltimore to look into the mystery which still surrounds the shooting. No claim has been put forth for the woman's body, and but for this decision it would finally be laid to rest in the Potter's field. The fact that the time was approaching when the estate of the late W. H. Bulkeley, of Hartford, to which the woman has always claimed to be the principal heir, was about to be divided is now thought to have had something to do with her sudden determination to end her life and that of her husband. The executors of the Bulkeley estate will divide the property tomorrow and with that division the falsity of Mrs. Smith's claims must have become known to her friends.

NEW YORK, Nov. 27.—Half dead from exposure, two young men, Charles Loser and George Doff, drifted in a disabled 15-foot sloop onto the Jersey shore at Point City Cove last night, and being revived told a story of having drifted at sea for over 72 hours in the face of cold rain and heavy wind of the last three days without food or drink. The men started out fishing Saturday in the sloop for an afternoon's sport. They did not carry any provisions. Caught in a squall they were blown to sea where they endured much suffering until they drifted ashore last night.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 27.—With the possible exception of one more witness the senate committee on military affairs, yesterday concluded the hearing of testimony bearing on the riot in Brownsville, Texas. It is expected that there will be two reports, one holding the colored soldiers were responsible for the shooting and justifying the course of the president in discharging them and another to be prepared by Senator Foraker, taking the position that the testimony had not been sufficient to hold the troops responsible.
