Nearly Thirty-Two Million Dollars Paid Out Annually.

From the "Illue Book" which is shortly to be issued, it appears there are 28, 947 employes of the Government residing in the District of Columbia, receiving \$31,541,225 annually. This does not count the Senators and Congressmen, and the session employes, committee clerks, private secretaries, etc. The government puts in circulation in Washington, more than fifty million dollars annually-its share of the District of Columbia expenses alone is between eight and nine millions. As all this is paid in "currency" and the payments are as regular as clock work, there is good reason why the "currency famine" has not been felt here to the same extent as elsewhere.
