Wholesale Price List as Reported Daily.

PORTLAND, Dec. 4.—Grocery jobbers do not think the five-cent decline in the eastern sugar market will affect Coast prices, yet the position of the market is regarded as weak, and both wholesalers and retailers are buying cautiously.
