STATE WILL NOT LOSE. PORTLAND, Dec. 7.—The State of Oregon will not lose a cent either through the failure of the Title, Guarantee & Trust Company or the temporary embarrassment of the Merchants' National Bank. The representatives of the American Surety Company, who are surety for State Treasurer Steel, today admitted the circumstances of their liability and will reimburse the state to the amount of \$408,388.88. This assures the restoration to the public treasury of all the state funds that were not adequately secured by approved securities. A payment of \$112,478.20 was made today. The deferred payments will carry 5 per cent interest.

A BAFFLING FIGURE

Organized Efforts Made to Upset Hughes' Presidential Chances.

CHRISTMAS WAR IN SCHOOLS

Father Knickerbocker's Wasteful Methods Cost Him Millions—New York's Quickest Church—Projects to Encourage Matrimony—Anti-Race Suicide Club.

NEW YORK, Dec. 7.—Hughes is the most baffling political figure that ever occupied an important position among presidential possibilities, "said a veteran politician this week, and this is the conclusion to which the ordinary observer is being forced. The New York Governor not only has announced that he will not attempt to secure the support of a single delegate to the national convention but this week he has quietly put an embargo on the delegate hunting efforts planned by some of his friends. At the same time the opposition to him has been fully organized. The triumvirate consisting of State Chairman Woodruff, Congressman Herbert Parsons and Speaker of the Assembly James W. Wadsworth, Jr., which forms the new Republican state machine, has planned, according to report, to annihilate the Governor's chances for the Presidency by blocking the reform measures which he will ask the state legislature to pass at its approaching session. It is well understood that these three men who control the Republican party machinery have constituted themselves the leaders of the Third term movement in this state and have placed their service at the disposal of the White House. On the other hand the corporate interests, fighting the Governor because of his public service commission bill and other similar legislation have been putting out feelers for a Cortelyou boom; basing the claims of the Secretary of the Treasury on his measures to relieve the recent money panic. In spite of the strenuous efforts to discredit him, however, and the fact that not a finger is being lifted to push the Governor's chances the Hughes movement is making headway in all parts of the country according to the reports that come to both the politicians and the newspapers here. That is why the political veteran described Hughes as a baffling political figure. The growth of his boom without any machinery behind it violates all the accepted traditions of the politicians. Apparently developments are rapidly approaching the point where Hughes is the only man in the country not interested in the Hughes boom.

Father Knickerbocker is a reckless spendthrift, at least that is the latest charge that has been made against the long-suffering old gentleman in knee breeches. As Comptroller Metz and Health Commissioner Darington are among those who make the charges there may be presumed to be some truth in them. The Comptroller points out that it costs \$400,000,000 a year to run the city or more than the combined expenditures of London, Paris and Berlin. It requires \$72,000,000 to cover the municipal pay roll alone and much of this is alleged to go for unnecessary salaries. In fact Mr. Metz asserts that the positions of one-third of the city's employes could be abolished without lessening the amount of work accomplished. Other wasteful items to which he calls attention are the interest charges amounting to millions, due to the city's habit of spending its income before it is collected. With the city's debt limit almost reached and with real estate taxes amounting to figures which are causing property owners to unite in protest these charges are attracting some attention from the usually indifferent New Yorker. Other statisticians have come to the front with the assertion that extravagance is not confined to the municipality but is a habit of the citizens, as well. They produce figures to show that New Yorkers are the most wasteful people on earth and that among the items that they virtually throw away are 45,900,000 gallons of water a day and the water problem is one of the most difficult and expensive with which the city has to deal and \$25,000,000 of food products wasted in the course of a year. Just at present, however, the people as well as the municipality are having some lessons in enforced economy that may help to improve their wasteful habits if they are really as bad as alleged.
