## RECEIVES A FORTUNE

Poor Widow Raised From Poverty to Affluance.

**AUNT LEAVES HER \$15,000,000** 

Poor Irishwoman Who With Her Sons Are Common Day Laborers Have Word That Her Aunt is Dead Leaving Many Millions.

NEW YORK, Dec. 16.-After five years of poverty, Mrs. Kate Cole of Williams. burg, seems likely to receive a fortune of half a million dollars. Mrs Cole is a widow and it supported by her only son, who is a common laborer. She came to America from Ireland and it is in Ireland that the fortune is. Some time ago Miss Johanna Seymour, Mrs Cole's aunt. died, leaving a fortune.

Mrs Cole was notified that there was a mall amount of money left to her, but she has been unable to secure it. Now she has received word from an old friend in Carrigtwhol, freland, to the effect that the fortune Miss Seymour left amounted to \$15,000,000.

Mrs. Cole and a Miss Graham, supposed to live on Staten Island, are the sole heirs. The letter to Mrs Cole stated that officials in Ireland and those having hold of the money were attempt ing to keep it from her. At about the same time she received a letter from a former official in County Cork, confirm ing the statements of the friend. Mrs. Cole has employed a lawyer, who has entered into communication with the public adminstrator of the county and with the American consul at Dublin.

CHICAGO, Dec. 16,-With the trials of the saloon keepers scheduled to be resamed today, the Sunday closing crusade took a mysterious turn yesterday, Sabbath bar sleuths, mysterious in their operations and more mysterious as to their affiliations, appeared in unexpected quarters in search of evidence of the

Clubs and restaurants were the scenes of the activities of the latest aggregation of law enforcement people. The Union League was the only club they succeeded in getting into and there they found the bar closed and no drinks being served. At several other clubs they were denied admission by the doormen.

The sleuths had an easier task in the restaurants. In a score of cafes in the loop district the detectives secured evidence that drinks were dispensed on Sun-

Just what body of the "forces that make for good" the detectives represented remains a mystery. They were disowned by the Chicago Law and Order League, and by Daniel Cruice, an attorney who is conducting a more or less mysterious prosecution of the downtown hotels for selling liquor on Sunday.
