RECEIVES A FORTUNE

Poor Widow Raised From Poverty to Affluence. AUNT LEAVES HER \$15,000,000

Poor Irishwoman Who With Her Sons Are Common Day Laborers Have Word That Her Aunt is Dead Leaving Many Millions.

NEW YORK, Dec. 16.—After five years of poverty, Mrs. Kate Cole of Williamsburg, seems likely to receive a fortune of half a million dollars.

Mrs. Cole was notified that there was a small amount of money left to her, but she has been unable to secure it. Now she has received word from an old friend in Carrigroh, Ireland, to the effect that the fortune Miss Seymour left amounted to \$15,000,000.

Mrs. Cole and a Miss Graham, supposed to live on Staten Island, are the sole heirs. The letter to Mrs. Cole stated that officials in Ireland and those having hold of the money were attempting to keep it from her. At about the same time she received a letter from a former official in County Cork, confirming the statements of the friend.
