WAGES COME DOWN

Railroad President Says That Gompers Mistakes.

LABOR HAS BEEN AT PREMIUM

Inexorable Law of Supply and Demand, Which is Basis of Political Economy Will Make Itself Felt in Case of Organized Labor.

PORTLAND, Ore., Dec. 19.-Looked upon a few years ago as one of the frontier counties of Eastern Oregon, where nothing grew except a large number of Coyotes and a few cattle and sheep, Morrow County's farm production this year is considered marvelous even in a state where rapid development is the rule.

With not more than one-sixth of its 1,300,000 acres under cultivation, this county has produced this year 2,750,000 bushels of wheat. Besides this, Morrow marketed 2,000,000 pounds of wool, 7,500 head horses and cattle, with enough hogs to raise the net return on all agricultural products to \$2,000,000 or \$400 for every man, woman and child in the county.

Land there that never knew plow or grain drill until last year, has grown this year 60 bushels of wheat to the acre; several 600 acre farms showing an average of more than 40 bushels per acre the entire tract. To haul the wheat crop of this one county the Oregon Railroad and Navigation Company must provide enough cars to make a train 20 miles in length.
