HEARING ON WOMEN SMOKING.

NEW YORK, Jan. 18 -- If there is anyone in New York who is willing to come to the defense of women who desire to smoke in public restaurant, he or she, will have an opportunity to be heard on Monday, when the committee on laws and legislation of the Board of Aldermen will give a public hearing on any case of Itching, Blind, Bleeding or the ordinance introduced by Alderman Protruding Piles in 6 to 14 days or Sullivan making it a misdemeanor for restaurant or hotel keepers to allow women to smoke in public rooms. The ordinance is the result of the recent action of several Broadway restaurants in removing the ban on women smoking in the public dining rooms.
