One of the most interesting facts that developed was that Mr. Harlan and Dr. Hektoen were retained by persons not known to have been affiliated with the anarchist leaders who had taken the initiative in defending the act of Averbuch.

The autopsy on the body of Averbuch was performed in the clinical laboratory at the Dunning insane hospital near the Potter's Field. The examination took place in the presence of city and county afficials and repreand friends of the dead boy. The gunshot wounds were examined with great minuteness and probed for the bullets, several of which were extracted from the body, to be used as exhibits at the inquest.

The body was then taken to Ridgelawn, a Jewish cemetery, and reburied.


