

INFORMAL MEETING

OF DEMOCRATS

An informal meting of the Democrats was held last evening in the council chamber to consider and discuss the feasability of putting a ticket in the field for the June election. Mr. J. T. Wallace called the meeting to order and stated the reason for it and invited nominations for a permanent chairman. Dr. Henderson was placed in nomination and upon the motion that nominations be closed the doctor was elected. Mr. A. D. Garner was elected secretary.

Barr strongly advocated a Citizen's near Eleventh. ticket, on the plea that as there were only 255 registered as Democrats in the county the probability of electing in the city is at "The Occident Hotel." a candidate would be lessened if he represented the Democracy alone. Mr. Kelly made an eloquent appeal for the pople present to stand as a unit for Democracy and the principles it stood for. The original motion being finally brought up for action it was unanimously voted to place a Democratic ticket in the field. A motion was made and carried to adjourn until next Wednesday evening at a place to be decided upon by the following committee of three: Messrs. Isaac Bergman, J. T. Wallace and R. M. Woodin. This was followed by a motion to notify all registered Democrats-either by mail or the press-of
