Columbia avenue to Duane street west. Accepted.

Improvement of Grand avenue from 7th street to 6th street. Filed.

Improvement of 6th street from Franklin avenue to Harrison avenue. Filed.

Report of committee on S. & P. W. recommending that the bid of Makkala and Woupio to improve 12th street, Commercial to Duane for the sum of \$1830 be accepted and that the bid of B. L. Ward to improve 9th street from Irving to Jerome for the sum of \$1636 be rejected. Adopted.

Ordinances.

Amending ordinance No. 1902 entitled an ordinance prohibiting minors from playing cars, billiards, pool or other games in any saloon, or in any place kept for card or billiard playing. Read 1st and 2nd time.

Appropriating the sum of \$— in part payment for improving Irving avenue from east line of Shively's to 40th street for the benefit of W. A. Goodin. Read 1st and 2nd time.

Extending the time for the completion of the Irving avenue from 18th street to east line of Shively's. Extended to October 1st. Read third time and passed under a suspension of the rules.

To improve Grand avenue from 7th and 6th streets on or before September 1st. Read third time and passed under a suspension of the rules.

Appropriating \$1135.40 out of the special fund for improving Lincoln avenue from Columbia avenue to Duane street (west) for the benefit of John Slotte. Read third time and passed under a suspension of the rules.

Providing for the time and manner of improving 6th street from Franklin avenue to Harrison avenue, September 1st. Read third time and passed under a suspension of the rules.

Re-establishing the grade on 6th street from Harrison avenue to Irving avenue. Read third time and passed under a suspension of the rules.

Granting franchise to Caltrop Fuel Co. Referred to committee on ways and means and city attorney.

Confirming special assessment roll No. 152 for improving Lincoln avenue from Columbia avenue to Duane street (west). Passed.

son to Irving avenue. Adopted. Authorizing the committee appointed to prepare the charter amendments to employ an assistant attorney for an amount not to exceed \$350. Adopted. To improve Kensington avenue from 8th to 11th streets. Adopted. To improve 8th street from Harrison to Irving avenue. Adopted. To improve 11th street, Exchange to Franklin. Adopted. To improve 11th street from Commercial to Duane, \$1926.50. Contract awarded to Makkala & Woupio. Adopted. Requisition for fire department supplies. Granted.

ROCKY TIMES AHEAD.

Not a Very Promising Outlook for the Thespians Until After Election.

NEW YORK, May 18.—The coming summer gives every promise of being the hardest one in years for the members of the theatrical profession. It has been a long time since there has been a disastrous season theatrically as the one just closed and there is no prospect of any better times for the actor for many months, in fact until after the election next fall. In the height of the season it was estimated that more than 2000 actors and actresses were out of work in New York, the largest number of unemployed in the profession for many years. A large number of companies that started in the season with every prospect of success were forced to close soon after the coming of the theatrical season. For this reason, even of actors that were employed early in the season, thousands were forced to be satisfied with very short seasons and were therefore unable to lay by the amounts required to keep them through the summer when work in their profession is always slack.

The actors' fund, the great charity of the theatrical profession, is not in a position to carry on the work which it will be asked to do, for at the annual meeting held a few days ago a deficiency of more than \$20,000 on the year's work was reported. The question of living through the summer is a serious one to hundreds of players, and Coney Island and other similar resorts are overrun with members of the profession who are seeking work of any sort that will provide food for the summer months. But in spite of the efforts of managers and others to do all in their power to assist those out of employment and money, it is certain there will be considerable suffering among members of the profession during the coming months.
