FLEET EXPERIMENT Dayton Squadron To Tow Torpedo Boats To Magdalena Bay

SAN FRANCISCO, June 8.—The Examiner says: A most unique but significant movement will be made within the next thirty days by the Pacific Fleet, under command of Admiral Dayton and the torpedo flotilla. The Dayton squadron is ordered to assemble in San Francisco harbor as a unit during the next fifteen days. The torpedo flotilla is ordered to report as a unit in the same harbor by June 10. At a date to be set by Admiral Dayton, under orders from the Navy Department, the cruiser squadron will take in tow the torpedo boats, sixteen in number and will at the fastest speed feasible, considering the safety of the smaller craft, proceed to Magdalena Bay, returning in the same way. Upon the success of this expedition will depend the conveyance of the torpedo boats to the Philippines under the same conditions.

BEEF PACKERS WORRIED

Price Of Beef Rises 1 to 2 Cents On Hundred Pounds.

NEW YORK, June 8.—Beef packers in the U. S. especially in this section of the country are very much concerned over the shortage in the beef supply. Since last week the price has risen from 1 to 2 cents on 100 pounds and the price is now around one third greater than it was the first part of June, 1907. The sharp rise in prices is said to be due entirely to the shortage in the supply of cattle in the market and already there is talk of having to have beef which was exported to England last winter shipped back to this country in cold storage. As a matter of fact the exportation of beef from New York is practically nothing and the packers not able to fill their contracts even with half the amount of beef they have engaged to ship. It is known that a number of the packers are letting contracts go entirely by the board and are paying their freight rate contracts with the Various steamship companies and keeping such meat as they have in this country, preferring to lose the price of the freight than to lose the freight together with being compelled to sell the meat in England at a much less sum than they pay for it on this side.

PERMANENT EXPOSITION.

Chicago Contemplates Exposition On Lake Front.

CHICAGO, June 8.—In a conference between T. Edward Wilder, general secretary of the Chicago Association of Commerce and Gustave Frohman, yesterday, the idea of a permanent exposition on lines similar to those of the World's Columbia Exposition, but smaller in scale, was discussed at length.

The principle was made that once many Chicagoans recognize that the old exposition on the lake front was in a large measure the parent of the large world's fair and much of the giant business of earlier days in Chicago was fostered, if not born in the old exposition building. This permanent exposition would be developed under the auspices of the Association of Commerce and housed in the great building which the association contemplates. The keynote of the exposition scene would be Music for the whole People of the West and Middle West, a rallying ground for art as well as a place for fostering the genius of the West in music and art with the underlying purpose of creating a great attraction for visitors and the advertising of all Chicago's business interests.

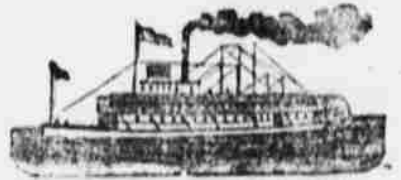
