## MILITARY PLANS

### Gen. Frederick Grant's Unique Marching Manuevers

### AUTOMOBILE EXPERIMENTS

Ten Detachments of Men to March From a Point Hundreds of Miles Apart, and Will Meet at a Common Center.

NEW YORK, June 11.—Unless something goes wrong in the calculations of Gen. Frederick D. Grant between now and next Sunday noon the 3,000 soldiers of the regular army under his command who are marching from every point of the compass toward the village of Deferjata, Jefferson County New York will perform a military feat unparalleled in the history of the American army.

When Gen Grant announced that he intended to march ten detachments of men from points hundreds of miles apart and have them meet at a common center within three hours of one another, military men of experience were inclined to say it could not be done.

After looking over reports from the commanding officers of the detachments, Gen. Grant stated that he fully expected to have all his troops arrive at the big camp at Pine Plain within one hour of the time set, which is Sunday noon.

More than 15,000 soldiers, regulars and militia, will participate in the manuevers.

One of the complete problems which the war department will try to work out will be the availability of the automobile for military purposes. To this end three officers started early this morning from the Governor's Island ferry to make the run to Pine Plains in an automobile and the same car, with possibly others, will be used through the manuevers in every possible way that military exigencies may require, thus undergoing a thorough test under the camp and campaign conditions.

Lt. Col. Edwin F. Glenn of the 23rd infantry, Captain William T. Johnson and Major Charles G. Woodruff, who will be the chief sanitary officers of the camp are making the automobile trip to Pine Plains. They expect to reach Albany tonight and at daybreak to start on the 170 mile trip from the state capitol to the camp, arriving there tomorrow night. Gen Grant will leave for the camp tonight.

### IMPORTANT INTERVIEW

#### Which Touches on Russian Policy In The Far East.

WASHINGTON, June 11.—The administration officials unofficially have been made acquainted with the essential features of an important interview recently had by the representatives of a Moscow newspaper with Mr. Malevsky Malevitch recently appointed Russian ambassador to Tokio which touches upon Russia's policy in the Far East. The views expressed by the ambassador, it is said, meet with the heart approval of the Russian foreign office. The tenor of Malevsky Malevitch's observations are pleasing also to the administration and to the diplomatic corps here as it indicates a desire and intention on the part of the Russian government to develop the peaceful relations establish with Japan. The Russian ambassador took the view that the conclusion of the treaty of commerce the fisheries convention entered into between Russia and Japan have definitely been established. Then he continued:

"My instructions are quite simple. I am called up to uphold and develop the neighborly relations which we have succeeded in establishing."

The ambassador said he was accustomed of being too pro-Japanese, a strange reproach he thought to be addressed a Russian. Yet, though remaining a Russian he said he could not deny that Japan had always interested him keenly.

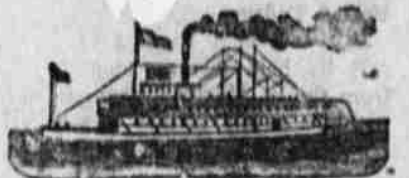
