It is its purpose to arouse and unify existing industrial organization that they may act rapidly and efficiently as circumstances require but that they shall be spared unnecessary effort or expense, their influence being concentrated and directed at the time and upon the specific point where it is required and under the circumstances which make it most effective. To this end there must not only be thorough agreement in policy but there must be thorough knowledge of the legislative situation. Most of all, it is important that the business citizen shall have impressed upon him the importance of presenting to his congressional representative his views upon matters that vitally affect his personal and property rights and the conduct and success not only of his own, but of all industry:

Political indifference is the great American sin. Its only cure is political interest by which men ascertain the meaning of legislative activity and impress upon their representatives the fact that they are keenly aware of the nature and quality of matters before them for judgment. This, and this alone, secures protection against the enactment into law of rules of conduct that may be more destructive of business and industry of personal and property rights, than fire, famine or cyclone, than panic, debt and failure.-James A. 
