TURKEYS SELLING AT THIRTY CENTS

GEESSE ALSO ARE HIGH, BUT THE PEOPLE ARE BUYING FREELY JUST THE SAME

Turkeys at 30 cents a pound and Thanksgiving only a few days off. A ten-pound turkey, dressed, means just three "plunks."

"Yes, turkeys are high this year," say the clerks in the stores, "but they are good."

One of the stores yesterday received a telegram stating that turkey orders could be filled wholesale at 24 cents; hence the retail dealer, after adding freight and other expenses, can't afford to sell below 30 cents.

Another store is receiving turkeys from up around Corvallis, and this place stated that it is not possible to sell below the 30-cent rate.

It is stated that geese are also dear and none too plentiful, and the prices of both turkeys and geese again brings up the fact that very few of either are raised in this county, while the demand here is constant and good.
