

The Daily Market Report

PORTLAND, Jan. 25.—Latest reports from the potato-growing districts adjacent to the city indicate the loss to the producers as a consequence of the recent freeze will be as heavy as was at first thought. A week ago it was estimated from 20 to 30 per cent of the tubers in pits and cellars had been frozen, but an accurate survey of the situation was then impossible. Conditions easily warrant an advance in cheese. There is very little cheese available now, and it will be a month or more before the supplies amount to much. Receipts of dairy produce for the week, as reported by the Board of Trade, were 236 cases of butter and 25 cases of cheese. The poultry market was a dull affair, as usual on Monday. There is a general scarcity of vegetables and the outlook is for a short supply of all California stuff for some time to come. The hide market on the whole is in a depressed condition, and on several grades the prices were raised half a cent to-
