Remarks at the Dedication of the National Cemetery at Gettysbur
Leurscore and seven years ago our fathers brought forth upon
tisis continent a new nation, conceived in liberty and dedicated to the proposition that all men are created equal.
Now we are engaged in a great civil war, tosting whether that nation, or any nation so conoeived and so dedicated, can long endure We are met on a great bald as angl resting place for come to ded gave their lives that that nation might live. It is altogether fittin and proper that we should do this.
But in a larger sense we cannot dedicate, we oannot consecrate we cannot hallow, this ground. The brave men, living and dead, whe tract. It is for us, the living rather, to be dedicated here to the anfinimhed work which they who fought here have thus far so nobly advarieed.
