TALK OF JEWS

CHICAGO, April 12.-Dr, Emil G Hirsch, whose alleged statement that the immigration of Russian Jews to this country ought to be prevented has stirred the Federation of Jewish Organizations of New York to take DEATH OF JOSEPH RUSSELL issue with him, denies having made the remarks credited to him.

"I did say that in view of prevail ing conditions in this country the move in founding a colony in Mesopotamia was a good thing for the Russian Jew." said Dr Hirsch, when shown the statement telegraphed from New York. "I did not make the statement that the Russian Jew to this country. I am not identified with the Mesopotamia movement personally, but there is a lot of merit in it and the future will show the wisdom of its progenitors."

WOMEN WHO WORK

CHICAGO, April 12.- The campaign of the Women's Trade League for an S-hour work day is an old issue according to a communication to that body by Dr. John B. Andrews of the University of Wisconsin. It really started during a strike of factory girls in Lowell, Mass., in 1834.

After several years of agitation, a ten hour law for women was passed by the Legislature of New Hampshire in 1847.

Dr. Andrews produced evidence that the tailoresses in New York had a union in 1825, the first organization of women workers in this country of which there is any record.

ITALY PURCHASES TONS

AMERICAN'S WEED GOES TO THAT GOVERNMENT'S MONOPOLY.

WASHINGTON, April 12.-The diplomatic correspondence of the State Department in 1906, made pubshould not be permitted to emigrate lic today, shows that the Italian government was buying yearly in Kentucky and Tennessee about 34,000,000 pounds of tobacco for the needs of the tobacco monoply. It was in connection with these

purchases that the Italian ambassador at Washington made a formal protest to the State Department for security against the depredations of "night riders". In replying to the ambassador's representations, Secretary Root suggested that the Italian government was purchasing the tobacco in its private capacity rather than as a sovereign.

"In such a case the Italian governments," said Mr. Root, "might seek redress in our courts of justice, because it is a settled law of this country that courts of justice are open to soverigns on the same terms as to private individuals for the protection of property rights."
