A \$200,000 FIRE.

Nearly all of the Business Portion of Town Burned.

FRENCH'S WAREHOUSE IS UNINJURED.

### Only one Hotel Escapes The Conflagration.

The Dalles was almost totally des troyed by fire on the 21st, inst. The fire commenced in the Pioneer Hotel. about 8 o'clock in the evening, and swept everything before it on First street from Waldron's drug store and Moody's to the Umatilla House, including that, and burned one side of Second street clear, as far as French & McFarland's. The blaze crossed over and burned everything from the corner opposite Fred Derber's old stand down as far as Michelbach's shop, including Humanson's brick, occupied by Mr. Newman, and burned up to Condon's law office, on the corner of Third street The Churches are occupied by homeless disheartening gloom.
