

**The Horse-Breeding Interest.**

[From the Inland Empire.]  
Last week we received the following letter from a well-known pioneer resident of Oregon, whose love for horses cannot be gainsayed:

July 12, 1879.

FRIEND MERRY.—I've read, from time to time, short articles from your ready pen upon the breeding of good horses in our growing State; and, without flattery, your articles have not been surpassed by any other gentleman in the State, according to my judgment. Since seeing you, I have seen many horses, both in California and our own State; but if I was to tell that I had seen any better horses in the trotting line than Eastern Oregon affords, I would tell you an untruth. A few more years of careful thought and judicious action on the part of our breeders of our trotters and runners, and Oregon will not play second fiddle to any state in the Union; and I ask as a personal favor that you keep this matter before the people. And in making this request, I am conscious that I echo the sentiments of many other lovers of good stock in this State.
