Oregon. and only by windows and ventilators, atundance of pure air is secured for the horses; while being introduced in moderate amount, and from various directions, it comes in without draught. Too much draught is almost an unknown stable luxury. To secure a constant supply of pure air, horses require more cubic space than they generally enjoy. Even when animals are stabled only at night, a medium of 1200 cubic feet should be allowed. In England the newer cavalry barracks giv a minium of 1500 cubic feet, with " ground area of fully 90 square feet per horse; and the best hunting and carriege horse stables have more room. - Journal of Chemistry.
