

Concerning Sheep.

Careful writers on the subject have noticed the general immunity from disease found in all flocks of American sheep; and this is a matter of much importance, giving to the United States special advantages as a sheep-breeding and mutton-producing country. Many of the diseases of sheep which are described as comparatively common in Europe are unknown in the United States; and this remark applies particularly to those which have proved so destructive abroad. Very many formidable maladies described by European writers are wholly unknown here, and others seldom met with, or if met with, occur in localities where they are not recognized. We have some foot rot and scab, it is true, with more or less colds, catarrh and gaub in the head, but in general our flocks are very healthy. Indeed, the Hon. H. S. Kendall, one of our best informed writers on this subject, expressed an opinion some years since that all the diseases of sheep in this country with which he was acquainted—and he had sent circulars for information upon this subject to all parts of the United States—did not cut off two per cent. annually of well fed and well managed grown sheep. One of our greatest drawbacks in sheep husbandry is the presence of so many useless, vicious dogs and their ravages are so alarming in many states as to raise a practical prohibition against sheep keeping. In the vicinity of towns and laage villages, where dogs abound, sheep are scarce; and but for this, all New England might be one vast sheepfold.

HEALTH OF HORSES.—The health and comfort of horses have of late years been greatly improved by the better construction of stables. They are now made more roomy and lofty, and provided with means of thorough ventilation. In many new stables lofts are done away with, or the floor of the loft is kept well above the horses' heads, and ample shafts are introduced to convey away foul air. By perforated bricks and gratings under the mangers, and elsewhere around the walls, and only by windows and ventilators, abundance of pure air is secured for the horse; while being introduced in moderate amount, and from various directions, it comes in without draught. Too much draught is almost an unknown stable luxury. To secure a constant supply of pure air, horses require more cubic space than they generally enjoy. Even when animals are stabled only at night, a medium of 1200 cubic feet should be allowed. In England the newer cavalry barracks give a minimum of 1500 cubic feet, with a ground area of fully 90 square feet per horse; and the best hunting and carriage horse stables have more room. — Journal of Chemistry.

A Fine Colt.

Some old fashioned men argue that it does not pay to raise fine stock as it takes too much time and trouble. They make a great mistake in their calculation as the following will prove: Last week Mr. E. Martin, of this city, purchased a colt twenty-five months old of James Brackett, of Canyon City, Grant county; for which he paid \$1500. The colt was sired by Champion Knox, with English Hunter as dam. This is a round figure to pay for a colt, yet it promises to step to the front as the fleetest flier in Oregon. — Bee July 23d.
