 wheat and a market in extent sufficient to consume all the flour that a mill could grind and timber to furnish 2 good saw mills and a market for many THOUSANDS OF FEET OF LUMBER, and we have the South Fork, all unappropriated, easy of application to all sorts of machinery. The fruit interest of our precinct were sadly neglected by its early settlers, yet there has been enough done to show that we have a splendid apple and berry climate, and as good peach and other tender fruits as can be found this far north, east of the Cascade Mts., as demonstrated in the small apple orchard of J. W. Lewis planted ten or twelve years since and the peach orchard of E. Lester planted four years ago, both of which bore so full of fruit the past season, the trouble was to keep the trees from breaking down. The yield of all kinds of melons, vines, squash, cucumbers and tomato vines was truly astonishing the past season, that potatoes, cabbage and turnips yield with each other in mammoth yield of succulent goodness. In my next (if you can eul any thing good enough to publish from this) I will give the history with the improvements of each place with the general Indian troubles we have had within our precinct since 1862, with stock stolen, citizens killed, game, fish, Public School, moral and social privileges etc., etc. Respectfully
