

This preciset is bounded as follows: Commencing at Junction Bar, on the North Fork of John Day river, thence easterly up that stream to the mouth of Slide creek, the ce southerbly to the head waters of Beach creck, thence west nly to the east line of North Fork precinct, thence northeraly on said line to place of beginning. Containing 65 legal voters, 33 of them have families, the remainder are bachelors. There are 75 children over 4 and under 20 years of age. We have had a six months school in this district this Winter, with an average daily at tendance of 22 scholars. The wages one of the most icolated precincts in this county. The principal part of the settlement has been made since the year 1876. We have beither grist or saw mill in this section. Therefore we either have to go to the Strawberry mill, a distance of 57 miles, or to Pendbeton, in Umatilla county, a distime of 125 miles, for our flour. The P. 
